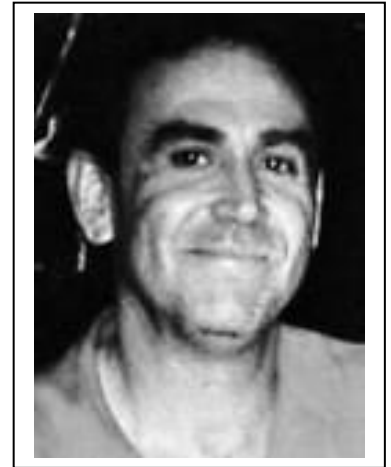


Paul Thomas Obituary
